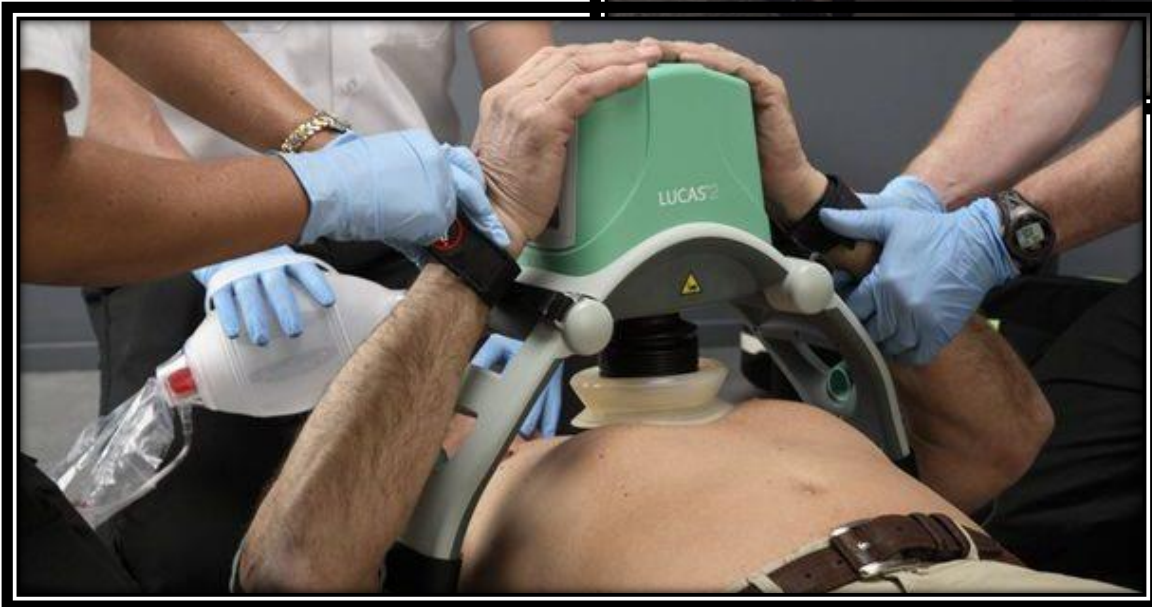

## **General 2016**

- Josh Patrick was welcomed as newest Wayne Township Trustee
- Residents of Wayne Township and the Village of Corwin voted to aggregate their energy supply
- Wayne Township and the Village of Waynesville held a successful *Recycle Rally* in conjunction with LCNB Community Shred Day
  - Collected nearly 6 tons of scrap tires, over 3 tons of scrap metal also collected the following: TVs, bulk trash, Freon and white goods.
- Snow and Ice removal equipment was converted to utilize a liquid beet-based de-icing solution
- Working with WCSWCD, OEEF and Boy Scout Troop #51, Wayne Township began a stream naming initiative
- Numerous Capital improvement projects

## **Fire Department 2016: Operations, Upgrades and Improvements**

- Responded to 219 Fire Runs and 901 EMS runs
- Purchased *LUCAS 2* CPR Machines with funding from Quaker Heights, Ohio EMS Grants, WFTD. Inc. and the Jake Yancey Memorial Fund
- Purchased eight (8) new sets of turn-out gear thanks to grant from the Loeb Foundation
- Purchased twelve (12) new pairs of boots
- WFTD, Inc. purchased fifty (50) new uniforms
- Purchased a bariatric wide body plate for cots
- Instituted new cancer prevention training and SOP
- Site for the new Wayne Township Fire House No. 2 was acquired

## **Fire Department Goals for 2017**

Increase volunteer staffing

Develop a part-time program for additional daily staffing

Identify needs for a new ambulance for 2018

Timeline for replacement of SCBA for 2018 purchase.

## **Roads Department: 2016 Highlights**

“Reclamite” applied to Gard Rd. as well as new 48” culvert pipe extension along with berm clearing and repair.

Completed O’Neal Rd. fence row removal and drainage upgrade as well as cleared and improved drainage at corner of O’Neal and Corwin Rds

Completed Pekin Rd. basket installation.  
Accepted phase 4 of Sandy Run subdivision

Upgraded two (2) single axel trucks to electronic speed control salt spreader systems and liquid pre-wet

Built new F-550 and equipped it with electronic speed control salt spreader systems and liquid pre-wet

Successfully liquidated excess Roads Department equipment

Installed new liquid tanks with plumbing and pumps to store liquid pre-wet materials

Purchased crack sealer/melter machine

Completed five (5) rounds of mowing.

Completed a third (3<sup>rd</sup>) section of the Corwin Rd./Little Miami Bike Trail clearing project and began work on a fourth (4<sup>th</sup>)

Dealt with tornadic storm damage from June 23-24 2016 storm

Continued fostering a close working relationship with the Warren County Engineer’s Office Highway Department through collaboration efforts

Participated in a successful *Recycle Rally* with the Village of Waynesville

Participated in the *Name that Stream* signage project, a collaborative program with the Boy Scouts and Warren County Soil and Water

Continued working with Warren County Parks on several projects regarding parks in the Township

## **Seasonal/Annual totals:**

- Approx. 225 tons of salt and grit spread on roadways for snow and ice removal in 2015-2016 winter season
- 4859 gallons of fuel used throughout the year
- Crack sealed 7.5 miles of roadway.
- 200.29 tons of asphalt applied for wedging and patching

## **2017 Goals**

Crack-seal all subdivision roads as well as those identified for resurfacing

Continue the Corwin Rd. clearing project

Continue with patching and wedging across the Township

Continue regular ditching activities

Continue New Burlington Rd. Cemetery improvement projects

Chip Seal 9 miles of road

## Zoning/Development Department: 2016 Highlights

- Wayne Twp. wrapped up a multi-year effort to update and revise the Zoning Code from the ground up.

- Twincreek subdivision became completely built-out
- Fiber optic network project in Sandy Run complete
- Windfield Estates subdivision approved
