To be eligible for the Warren County Township Association (WCTA) Scholarship, the student must have at least a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and attain a minimum 22 ACT and/or 1000 SAT score. Applicants must be able to demonstrate outstanding citizenship through service and participation in community activities. Immediate family members of Township Trustees or Fiscal Officers are not eligible.

- Statement of activities, honors and leadership, including school and community activities, and years participated. Identify leadership positions or awards received.
- A copy of your high school transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation (personal or professional).
- A 500-750 word essay, double spaced, on the importance of township government in Ohio, detailing:
  - 1. How a township has impacted you or your life, and
  - 2. What you learned from attending the township meeting.

The applicant <u>MUST</u> attend at least one township meeting <u>BEFORE</u> turning in the application.
